**Rhythm Cat** is a fun way to learn to read beats. Tap and hold the green button to copy the note duration. The app adds complexity as you progress. You get rated after each level is complete, and once you master it, you get to move on.



**Rhythm Repeat** is a great way to practice repeating a rhythm you hear. This will test your skill to keep up with rhythms that will get harder with each one you pass.



**Rhythm Training** is another fun way to learn to read beats. Pick your tempo then hit play. Use the drum to play along with the rhythm.
